## Health certificate instructions for visitors (interns, student trainees, visiting physicians etc.) of the Charité-Universitätsmedizin-Berlin

#### Dear Visitor,

You will soon be working at the Charité-Universitätsmedizin Berlin as a visiting intern, student trainee, visiting physician or in another capacity. Before you can begin in your position, we require that you turn in the following documents 4 weeks before the starting date of employment:

### 1. For all positions:

- Medical attestation from a general/treating physician about your physical fitness (see enclosure) or an occupational health certificate from a company physician.

# 2. The following laboratory values are required for positions with patient contact and/or the handling of blood, body fluids and excretions:

- Hepatitis B marker: anti-HBc, anti-HBs in u/l, HBs antigens
- Hepatitis C marker: anti-HCV
- ALT (GPT), Gamma-GT

### 3. Additionally required for positions dealing with children:

- Hepatitis A antibodies
- Measles antibodies
- Mumps antibodies
- Rubella antibodies
- Chickenpox antibodies

Please give the documents required for the health certificate in a separate sealed envelop marked with "health documents" to the responsible staff member in the Department - **Geschäftsbereichs Personal, Personalbetreuung, B 7 B/C.** The sealed documents will then be submitted to a physician in the Center for Occupational Medicine for a final health assessment.

If you desire, required examinations can also be performed in the Center for Occupational Medicine. In this case, the costs incurred by the Charité will be billed to you as a "self-pay" patient.
